
"My mother has the early onset of Alzheimer's. I have moved form abroad to London in order to live with her and support her. We are finding it difficult balancing work and life."

"My mother is currently in Intermediary care following a second operation on her broken leg. She is 83, my father is 86 - they live at home, but she has now been in hospital (5 weeks) and intermediary care (3-4 weeks). I am concerned that she is going backwards and would like to speak to someone about options for full time home care, and in worst case scenario residential care for both her and my father (they will want to be together)"





- Online requests made outside office hours picked up next working day.






