

## The Trade Union (Facility Time Publication Requirements) Regulations 2017

The Trade Union (Facility Time Publication Requirements) Regulations 2017 require us to publish information on trade union facility time relating to a 12 month relevant period.

The University recognises the important role of union officials and the benefits of facility time for the institution and recognises three trade unions for the purposes of collective representation of separate University staff groups:

- University and College Union (UCU) (previously known as the AUT): academic and academic related staff
- Unite (previously known as Amicus): University support staff
- Unison: University support staff

The data tables below provide the required information for 1 April 2020 to 31 March 2021.

**Table 1 - Relevant Union Officials**

What was the total number of your employees who were relevant union officials during the relevant period?
